"We appreciate the opportunities Sysco has given us to bring value to their business with innovative technology that saves money and reduces energy consumption, while providing better lighting for their operations and employees."

Orion has retrofitted more than 60 Sysco facilities nationwide with its Compact Modular(tm), high-intensity fluorescent technology designed to save customers approximately 50 percent on light-related energy costs while providing 50 percent more light. Several Sysco facilities also have implemented Orion's InteLite(r) wireless control system and patented Apollo(tm) Solar Light Pipes, which harvest natural daylight and direct it to the facility floor without using electricity.

In describing Orion at the awards banquet, Gary Cullen, vice president of distribution services, said Orion "revolutionized the industry with the development of its high-intensity fluorescent technology platform. Their superior technology, advanced controls and its vision of the future have helped (Orion) earn the business of many well-respected and successful companies throughout the United States."

Cullen also called Orion "an industry leader in product innovation and development in the energy and lighting fields."

The award winner was chosen by the popular vote of Sysco's broadline distribution companies in the United States and Canada. John Scribante, Orion's senior vice president of business development, credits the win to the fact that voters from facilities that were upgraded with Orion technology over the last four years continue to reap the benefits of the energy savings today.
